



Stephanie L. Hanson, Ph.D., is the executive associate dean and a clinical professor in the UF College of Public Health and Health Professions. In her current position, Dr. Hanson oversees significant components of PHHP academic program development. She chairs the PHHP Blended Learning Task Force, which is spearheading the implementation of the college's vision for a pedagogical educational model in which the use of technology and a blending of online and interactive live class sessions facilitate student learning. She is also integrally involved in implementation of the college's strategic plan. A member of the college since 1996, Dr. Hanson received her Ph.D.'s in developmental psychology and clinical psychology from Vanderbilt University. She was one of the first women board certified in rehabilitation psychology by the American Board of Professional Psychology. She is also a fellow of the American Psychological Association based on her significant contributions to the field of rehabilitation psychology, particularly in the area of ethics.
